

300 Cable tray support spacing



Overview

Industry standards often recommend at least 300mm (12 inches) of spacing between power and control trays to minimize EMI. The spacing stated for horizontal runs may be applied also to runs at an angle of more than 30 Degrees from the vertical. The mechanical and electrical characteristics, tests, certifications, overall quality management, recommendations mentioned. Ladder cable tray is available in widths of 6, 9, 12, 18, 24, 30, 36, 42 and 48 inches with rung spacings of 6, 9, 12 or 18 inches. Specifiers should be aware that some cable tray. Where products of five metre lengths or above are packed in bundles, they shall be supported with a minimum of three timber bearers which provide sufficient clearance to accommodate the forks of a forklift truck. Bearers shall be spaced evenly along the length of the bundle. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require. The support distance is the distance between the centres of two adjacent support elements.

Cable Support Distances

The length between support positions will change depending on the cable design, size, materials and weight. For example, an MDPE sheathed cable will be stiffer and therefore require a greater distance
