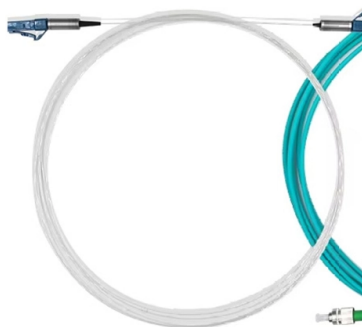


Aesthetically pleasing wiring methods for equipment distribution boxes
