CAS (Centralized Access System) cables are simplex drop cables designed for indoor FTTH applications. They typically feature a single-mode fiber, reinforced with aramide yarn for strength, and a LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) jacket for safety in indoor environments (OPTRAL CAS) . - Orange

- Green
- Brown
- Slate
- White
- Red
- Black
- Yellow
- Violet
- Rose
- Aqua For cables with more than 12 fibers, the color sequence is repeated with stripe markings to distinguish additional fibers. For example, in a 48-fiber cable, fibers are grouped into tubes, each tube following the 12-color sequence, and additional stripes indicate the tube number .

Jacket and Connector Identification

- Outer Jacket Colors: CAS cables may use colored jackets or printed legends to indicate fiber type, count, or performance (e.g., single-mode, multi-mode, or polarization-maintaining fibers) .
- Connector Color Coding: Connectors and strain relief boots maintain the same color code as the fiber to ensure consistent identification across the connection interface .

- Quickly identify individual fibers for splicing or termination.
- Avoid misconnections in high-density installations.
