Ensure trays are not undersized to prevent overheating or oversized to avoid wasted space .

2. Site Preparation

Material Inspection: Verify all trays, ladders, and accessories for damage and compliance with approved submittals. Remove unsuitable materials . **Storage:** Store trays horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports at 1-meter intervals, protected from moisture and sunlight . **Marking Routes:** Mark tray routes on-site according to drawings, ensuring no clashes with other services and maintaining clearance for cable pulling and maintenance .

3. Mounting and Supports

Support Spacing: Install supports at intervals of 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type and load . **Alignment:** Ensure trays are level, straight, and properly connected using splice plates and fittings . **Hanging Systems:** Use appropriate brackets, clamps, and hangers to secure trays to walls, ceilings, or floors .

4. Cable Laying

Organize Cables: Lay cables neatly, separating by voltage and function. Use cable ties or straps to maintain order . **Slack and Expansion:** Leave sufficient slack for thermal expansion, movement, and future adjustments . **Rollers for Long Runs:** Use cable tray rollers to prevent kinks and damage during installation .

5. Grounding and Bonding

Electrical Safety: Metal trays must be grounded and bonded using proper jumpers to maintain electrical continuity and comply with standards . **Compliance:** Follow IEC 61537, NEC Article 392, and local building codes .

Cable Identification: Label all cables clearly for identification and troubleshooting . **Wiring Map:** Maintain updated documentation for future maintenance and audits .

Final Checks: Inspect for loose clamps, misalignment, overfilled sections, or unsupported spans . **Routine Maintenance:** Perform periodic checks for corrosion, loose wires, or broken clamps to ensure long-term reliability .
