Corrosion protection is essential due to tunnel environmental conditions. **Standards:** Cable tray systems in tunnels must comply with fire, structural, and electrical safety standards such as IEC 61537, NFPA 130, EN 45545, and DIN 4102-12. Fire-resistant trays can maintain functionality for 30, 60, or 90 minutes during a fire, ensuring emergency systems remain operational .

Mounting: Trays are anchored to tunnel walls or ceilings using brackets, threaded rods, or strut systems. Modular sections allow the tray to follow the tunnel's path, including curves and slopes . **Bundling and Layering:** Cable clamps and dividers organize individual cables or bundles. Multi-layer tray systems enable separation of high-voltage, low-voltage, and communication cables while optimizing space . **Firestopping:** Firestop modules, such as expanding foam barriers, prevent fire propagation along cable routes, enhancing tunnel safety .
