Concrete cable trays, also known as cable troughs, are usually manufactured from reinforced precast concrete to provide strength, durability, and resistance to environmental factors such as weather, chemical exposure, and mechanical loads. The concrete grade is selected to ensure the tray can safely support the weight of cables, covers, and any maintenance loads.

- Typical Grade: C25/30 (characteristic compressive strength of 25 MPa at 28 days, with a cube strength of 30 MPa) is commonly used for standard cable trays in civil and utility projects. For heavy-duty applications, higher grades such as C30/37 or C35/45 may be specified.
- Reinforcement: Steel reinforcement is embedded to improve tensile strength and prevent cracking under load. Fibre-reinforced concrete is also used in some systems to enhance durability and reduce maintenance.



- **Environmental Considerations:** For outdoor or harsh environments, concrete may include additives for freeze-thaw resistance, sulfate resistance, or reduced permeability to protect against corrosion and chemical attack .
