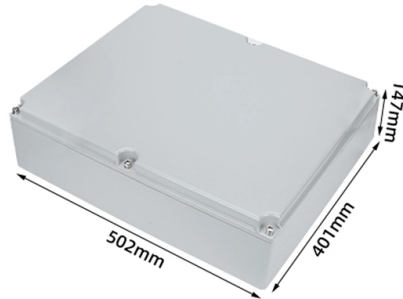

They provide an open framework that allows easy access, inspection, and modification of cabling, and are often used where frequent changes or additions to wiring are anticipated. Common types include ladder trays, ventilated trough trays, solid-bottom trays, and wire mesh trays, each offering varying levels of ventilation, protection, and load capacity. Wiring ducts, on the other hand, are rigid enclosures or channels used primarily inside electrical panels or enclosures to organize and protect cables. They often feature slots or fingers for easy routing and termination of wires, and are generally smaller and more confined than cable trays. Wiring ducts are typically used for internal panel wiring rather than large-scale cable routing.
