The main power cable, also called the feeder cable, brings electricity from the utility or main supply into the distribution box. It must be sized to handle the total anticipated load of all sub-circuits within the box. For example, a 60A single-phase system may require a 16mm² cross-sectional area for both phase and neutral conductors . The feeder cable typically enters the distribution box through designated entry points on the top or bottom of the enclosure, which may include knockouts or conduit connections .

Sub-Circuit Cable Connections



Sub-circuit cables distribute power from the distribution box to individual circuits, such as lighting, outlets, or appliances. Each sub-circuit is connected to a dedicated circuit breaker or fuse inside the box. Proper cable management is essential: cables should be neatly routed, secured, and insulated to prevent damage or short circuits . Neutral and earth wires are connected to their respective bus bars, ensuring proper grounding and safety .

Safety and Compliance

- **Enclosure Protection:** The distribution box should have an appropriate IP or NEMA rating to protect against dust, moisture, and physical damage .
- **Grounding:** Metal boxes must be properly grounded to maintain electrical continuity .
- **Cable Entry Hardware:** Use bushings, clamps, or conduit fittings to prevent conductor damage at entry points .
- **Circuit Protection:** Each incoming and outgoing cable should be protected by a breaker or fuse to prevent overloads and short circuits .
- **Inspection:** Before powering on, perform visual checks and use a multimeter to verify correct connections and insulation integrity .

Best Practices

- Label all circuits for easy identification and future maintenance .
- Maintain separation between high-voltage and low-voltage cables if present.
- Ensure cables are not bent sharply and have sufficient slack for maintenance.
- Schedule regular inspections to detect wear, corrosion, or loose connections . By following these guidelines, the cable system entering a distribution box will be safe, organized, and compliant with electrical standards, reducing the risk of faults, fire hazards, and equipment damage .
