Fiber optic patch cords, also called fiber jumpers, are short cables with connectors on both ends designed to interconnect devices like switches, servers, and patch panels. To use them with a switch, the switch must have optical ports or SFP/SFP+ transceiver modules installed. The patch cord connects the transceiver in one switch to a transceiver in another switch or to a patch panel, enabling high-speed optical communication.

Types of Fiber and Connectors

- Single-mode (SM): Used for long-distance connections, typically with OS1/OS2 fiber.
- Multimode (MM): Used for short-distance connections within data centers, such as OM3/OM4 fibers.

- **Connectors:** Common types include LC, SC, and MTP/MPO, with LC being widely used in modern data centers due to its small form factor and compatibility with QSFP transceivers .

Best Practices

- **Match fiber type:** Ensure the patch cord matches the fiber type of the switch transceivers (SM or MM) to avoid signal loss .
- **Check distance and power budget:** The total link length should not exceed the maximum supported distance for the fiber type and transceiver .
- **Maintain proper polarity:** TX (transmit) and RX (receive) must be correctly aligned; twisted patch cords can affect polarity if not installed properly .
- **Use pre-terminated cables:** Pre-terminated patch cords save installation time and reduce errors, providing low insertion loss and high reliability .
