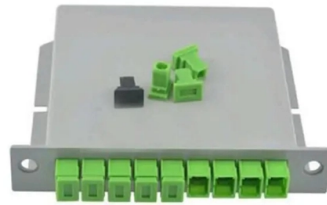


Can single-core wires be run in cable trays

Single-core conductors are permitted in cable trays under NEC Article 392, provided they are rated for tray use and suitable for open-air environments, such as Tray Cable (TC) or Metal-Clad (MC) cables . Common single-conductor building wires like THHN/THWN, XHHW, and RHH/RHW can also be used if they are 1/0 AWG or larger and marked for tray installation . Grounding conductors must be larger than 4 AWG but do not require tray marking.

Circuit Grouping and Arrangement

When using single-core cables, circuit grouping is mandatory. NEC 392.20(C) requires that all single-conductor installations be grouped by phase to prevent inductive heating of the tray structure . Randomly distributing single-core wires without grouping can cause magnetic field interactions, overheating, and potential fire hazards. Proper phase sequence and arrangement ensure balanced current distribution and reduce the risk of cable damage

Ampacity and Fill Considerations

Cable ampacity in trays differs from conduit installations. Single-core cables must follow ampacity derating rules based on the number of current-carrying conductors and tray configuration . Ladder trays provide better ventilation and allow higher fill capacity, while solid-bottom trays may require additional spacing. For power cables, tray fill should not exceed 40% of the tray cross-sectional area, and for control cables, 50% . Stacking or bundling cables increases the need for derating.

Installation Best Practices

- Maintain open, accessible trays; avoid hoistways or enclosed spaces .
- Use sunlight-resistant cables for outdoor installations.
- Secure cables at intervals not exceeding six feet, especially for TC-ER or ITC-ER cables .
- Separate high-power and low-power cables to prevent electromagnetic interference .
- Ensure proper mechanical support and protection against physical damage.

Summary

Single-core wires are fully acceptable in cable trays if they are sufficiently large ($\geq 1/0$ AWG), tray-rated, grouped by circuit, and installed according to NEC 392 rules. Proper arrangement, ampacity derating, and adherence to fill limits are essential to maintain safety, prevent overheating, and ensure long-term reliability of the electrical system .
