Overview

Cold aisle containment systems use doors at aisle ends, ceiling panels or lids above racks, and structural frames to create enclosed zones where cold supply air flows directly to IT equipment intakes. Without containment, cold supply and hot exhaust air mix throughout the data. The cold aisle layout is the most common starting point in data center design. Server racks are arranged in rows so that the fronts of the racks face each other, forming a corridor known as the cold aisle. Cold air is delivered into this aisle through: Servers pull this cold air into their front. Frame components are pre-assembled and fully floor supported with rack attachments for lateral stability. Thanks to the specially designed fixing and flexible plastic isolation elements, the hot aisle. More frequently, data centers are using hot and/or cold aisle cooling containment solutions to help with managing airflow, eliminating hot spots and improving energy efficiency.
