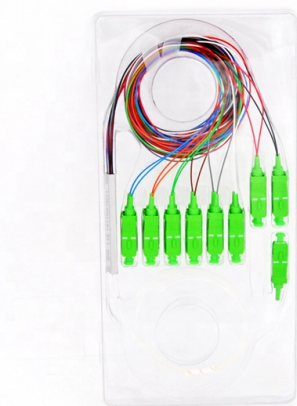


Connecting a drop fiber optic cable to a regular fiber optic cable

Drop fiber optic cable not only forms the final external link between the user and the feeder cable, also makes the fiber much closer.

Drop cables are the final segment in a fiber optic network, bridging the main backbone to end-user premises. They are typically compact, lightweight, and flexible, with 1-4 fibers (sometimes up to 12) and are designed for both indoor and outdoor use. They may include strength members like fiberglass or steel and protective jackets to withstand environmental stress.

Preparation for Connection

- **Safety First:** Always wear safety glasses and gloves and avoid looking directly into fiber ends that may carry laser light.
- **Cable Access:** Identify the fiber subunit and messenger subunit in the drop cable. Use a utility knife to carefully slit the web or outer jacket without damaging the fibers.



- **Measure and Mark:** Determine the length of fiber needed for splicing or termination, leaving enough slack to route the fiber from the attachment point to the splice closure or termination box .

Methods of Connection

- **Fusion Splicing:** The most reliable method, where fiber ends are precisely aligned and fused using a splicing machine. This provides low-loss, permanent connections suitable for high-speed networks .

- **Mechanical Splicing:** Uses a splice holder to align fibers without fusion. It is faster but may have slightly higher signal loss.

- **Preterminated Connectors:** Drop cables can come with preinstalled connectors that plug directly into network terminals, eliminating the need for splicing and reducing labor .

Installation Considerations

- **Bend Radius:** Do not exceed the cable's minimum bend radius to prevent signal loss or fiber breakage .

- **Tension and Pulling:** When pulling cables through ducts or conduits, monitor tension to avoid fiber damage .

- **Protection:** Use splice closures, pedestals, or aerial clamps to protect the connection from environmental factors .

- **Testing:** After connection, test the fiber with an OTDR or power meter to ensure proper signal transmission and low loss .
