Design requirements for low voltage distribution boxes cover NEC, IEC, and safety standards to ensure reliable, compliant electrical installations. You must make safety your top priority when working with low voltage distribution boxes. This document is not intended as a substitute for a detailed study or operational and site-specific development or schematic plan. It is not to be. MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers) protect individual circuits from overcurrent and short circuits. Choosing the right MCB requires considering rated current. The guide lists the process of design, assembly and documentation of a low-voltage switchgear assembly in the order of the necessary steps and at the same time assigns to these steps the relevant sections from the standard IEC 61439 / EN 61439.
