Mounting Height

Front Clearance

- Minimum 3 feet (≈ 914 mm) in front of the panel is required to allow full access and safe operation .

- Panel doors must be able to open at least 90° without obstruction .

- No storage, pipes, or other equipment should block this working space .

Side Clearance

- Minimum 30 inches (≈ 762 mm) from the sides of the equipment, or at least the width of the equipment itself, to allow safe side access .

- For rows of equipment in commercial or industrial settings, aisles between rows should be at least 4 feet wide, increasing with higher voltages .

Height Clearance

- Minimum headroom in front of the equipment should be 6.5 feet (≈ 2 meters) or the height of the equipment, whichever is greater .

- Dedicated space should extend from the floor to 6 feet above the equipment or to the structural ceiling .

Dedicated Space

- A dedicated vertical space from the floor to 1.8 meters (6 ft) is required for panelboards to ensure safe access and maintenance .

- Equipment should not extend more than 6 inches beyond the front of the panelboard .

Environmental Considerations

- Panels should be installed in dry, accessible areas free from water, excessive dust, or other adverse conditions .

- Outdoor installations require enclosures with appropriate IP or NEMA ratings to protect against moisture and dust .

Summary

To comply with safety standards and ensure proper access:

- Maintain 1–1.8 m mounting height for residential panels.
 - Provide 3 ft front clearance, 30 in side clearance, and 6.5 ft headroom.
 - Ensure dedicated space from floor to 1.8 m and unobstructed panel doors.
 - Install panels in safe, dry, and ventilated locations with proper enclosure ratings.
