Fiber optic cables carry data as light signals, which cannot be directly interpreted by most consumer routers. To use fiber internet at home, the fiber line from your ISP usually terminates at an Optical Network Terminal (ONT). The ONT converts the optical signal into an electrical signal that can be transmitted over Ethernet to your router. After conversion, you connect the ONT to your router's WAN or Internet port using a standard Ethernet cable.

Routers with Fiber Support

Some high-end or enterprise-grade routers include SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) ports that can accept fiber modules. These routers can directly interface with fiber cables if the correct SFP module is installed. However, most consumer routers, including popular models like ASUS or TP-Link, do not have native fiber ports, so the ONT is required to bridge the connection.

Why Direct Fiber Connection is Rare

Fiber and Ethernet use fundamentally different signaling methods. Fiber transmits data as light pulses, while Ethernet uses electrical signals. Without a conversion device like an ONT or a compatible SFP module, the router cannot interpret the fiber signal. Even media converters or adapters are generally insufficient for GPON or XGPON fiber protocols used by ISPs, making the ONT essential for proper operation.
