Telecom operators confirmed that two critical systems—the South East Asia-Middle East-Western Europe 4 (SMW4) and the India-Middle East-Western Europe (IMEWE) cable networks—were severed, impacting data flow between regions. The damage is believed to have occurred in waters near. Damage to key fiber-optic systems slows connectivity across India, Gulf, and wider Asia.
