Any particle or residue present at the interface can scatter or absorb light, disrupt the core alignment, and even scratch the glass. They provide modularity, easy installation, and flexibility—advantages that fusion splicing cannot offer. Network operators claim that 15-50% of all network problems can be traced to dirty connectors causing connection problems.
