Grounding Considerations

While the fiber core itself does not carry electrical current, many fiber optic cables include metallic components such as steel armoring, copper strength members, or metallic messenger wires. These components must be grounded to prevent electric shock, equipment damage, or fire hazards . Fully dielectric cables without metal content do not require grounding .

Grounding Steps

- Identify metallic components in the cable or conduit.
- Bond and ground each metallic element according to applicable codes, such as NEC Article 770 and NFPA 70 .
- Use a UL-listed copper grounding conductor (commonly 6 AWG) and clamp to connect metallic components to the building or pole grounding electrode .
- Ensure the grounding conductor runs in as straight a line as practicable to minimize resistance and maintain compliance with ANSI/TIA/EIA standards .
