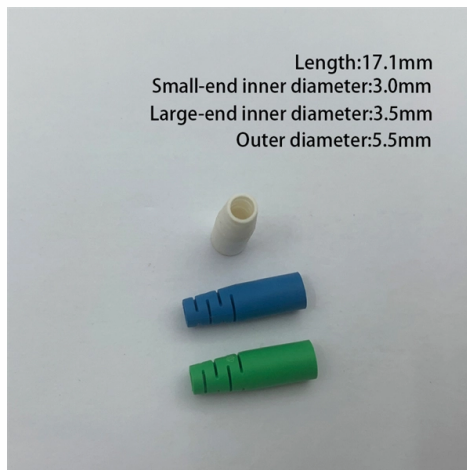

Grounding Considerations

However, if the cable contains metallic components such as steel armoring, copper strength members, or metallic messenger wires, grounding is mandatory to prevent electric shock, equipment damage, or fire hazards . Grounding should follow standards like the NEC Article 770 and NFPA 70, ensuring metallic members are bonded at entry points and terminations . Fully dielectric cables without metal content do not require electrical grounding, which simplifies installation and reduces costs . When using metallic conduits or trays, these must also be grounded according to electrical codes, independent of the cable type .

Best Practices

- Maintain proper cable depth and segregation from other utilities to avoid damage .
- Use service loops at street crossings and termination points for maintenance flexibility .
- Clearly mark cable routes to prevent accidental damage during future construction .
- Follow industry standards for splicing, termination, and testing to ensure signal quality and network reliability . By selecting the appropriate installation method and adhering to grounding and safety standards, fiber optic cables on the ground can provide reliable, long-term performance while minimizing risks from environmental and electrical hazards.
