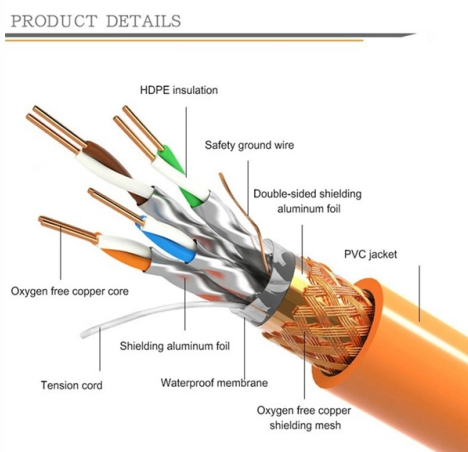

- Fire Safety: PE is not inherently fire-retardant. For indoor or plenum applications, materials like LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) are preferred due to low smoke and toxicity in case of fire .

- Application Environment: PE is best suited for outdoor, underground, or industrial environments where fire risk is minimal but environmental exposure is high .

PE outer sheaths are ideal for outdoor fiber optic cables due to their durability, UV and moisture resistance, and mechanical toughness. HDPE is preferred for long-term outdoor deployments, while LDPE offers flexibility for installations requiring frequent bending.
