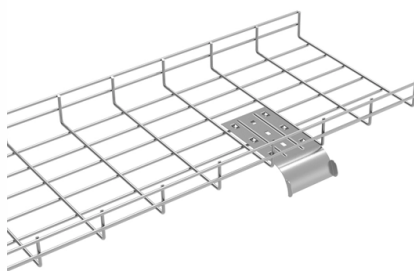

Fiber optic patch cord connectors are designed to ensure precise alignment between fiber ends for optimal signal transmission. The shape of a connector depends on its type:

- LC (Lucent Connector): A small form factor connector with a rectangular, push-pull design, often used in high-density data centers. It has a compact, slightly tapered ferrule that aligns the fiber core precisely within the adapter .
- SC (Subscriber Connector): A square, snap-in connector commonly used in PON networks. Its ferrule is cylindrical but housed in a square plastic body, providing a secure fit .
- ST (Straight Tip): A cylindrical connector with a bayonet-style twist-lock mechanism, often used in legacy networks. The ferrule is round and extends slightly from the connector body .

Simplex vs Duplex Assemblies

Connectors can be assembled in simplex (single fiber) or duplex (two fibers side by side) configurations. Duplex connectors are often referred to as "zip cords" because the two fibers are joined in a single jacket but can be separated if needed. The assembly style affects how the connectors are handled but does not change the ferrule shape itself.

Functional Implications

The shape of the connector, whether flat, tapered, or cylindrical, is critical for:

- Optical alignment: Ensures minimal signal loss and reflection.
- Compatibility: Must match the adapter or transceiver port.
- Ease of installation: Push-pull or snap-in designs simplify insertion and removal in high-density racks.
