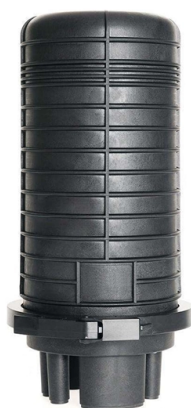


Function of the optical fiber connector box

Fiber Termination Box, also known as FTB, typically consists of two main parts: the outer shell body and the adapter tray that protects the fiber connector points. It is a crucial component in fiber optic networks, primarily used for terminating, connecting, and managing fiber. Serving as a critical connection point, FTB facilitates the termination, splicing, or connection of fibers from various cables to other network devices such as switches, routers, or Optical Network Terminals (ONTs). ① After the fixed function optical cable enters the rack, its outer sheath and reinforcing core shall be mechanically fixed, ground wire protection parts shall be installed, end protection. In short, the terminal box is the last structured node of the Fiber Optic System before service touches the subscriber. A typical PON topology (GPON, XGS-PON, or 25G PON) flows OLT → fiber distribution hub → passive splitters → distribution/drop fibers → premises. It is widely deployed in FTTH, FTTB, and other access networks to ensure stable signal transmission from backbone cables to end.
