

Green light on the power distribution box socket

A green light on a GFCI or power distribution socket indicates that the outlet's internal electronics are powered and the safety self-test has passed, but it does not guarantee that electricity is flowing to the outlet slots. What the Green Light Means

The green indicator on a GFCI outlet confirms that the internal circuitry is energized and operational, meaning the outlet can monitor for ground faults and is ready to trip if necessary. It is a status signal for the safety function, not a confirmation that the outlet is delivering power to connected devices. The light is powered separately from the mechanical contacts that supply electricity to the plug, so the outlet can appear "active" while the load side remains unpowered.

Common Reasons for No Power Despite the Green Light

- **Incorrect Wiring:** If the wires are connected to the wrong terminals (LINE vs LOAD), the outlet may show a green light but fail to provide power. Ensuring black (hot) and white (neutral) wires are correctly attached to the LINE terminals is crucial.
- **Tripped Circuit Breaker:** A breaker in the main panel may have tripped partially or fully. Resetting the breaker by switching it off and then back on can restore power.

- Upstream GFCI: Another GFCI outlet upstream may have tripped, cutting power to downstream outlets even if the green light is on .
- Faulty or Old Outlet: The GFCI itself may be defective or at the end of its lifespan, requiring replacement .
- Physical Damage or Loose Wires: Pinched, damaged, or loose wires can prevent power from reaching the outlet slots while still allowing the internal electronics to function .

Troubleshooting Steps

- Check the breaker: Ensure the circuit breaker is fully reset.
- Inspect wiring: Verify that the LINE and LOAD connections are correct and secure.
- Test upstream outlets: Reset any upstream GFCIs that may affect the circuit.
- Cycle the GFCI: Press the TEST and RESET buttons to ensure the outlet is properly reset .
- Replace the outlet: If wiring and breakers are correct but power is still absent, the GFCI may need replacement . Understanding that the green light is a safety status indicator rather than a power guarantee helps prevent confusion and guides proper troubleshooting.
