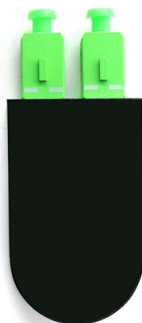

This allows a single router port to indirectly handle multiple fiber links, especially in backbone or high-bandwidth setups.

- Duplex requirement: Each connection typically requires two fibers (one for sending, one for receiving) for standard Ethernet applications .

- Bandwidth needs: High-speed applications (10, 25, 100 Gb/s) may require multiple fibers per connection using parallel optics .
