- External cables (used for long-distance or outdoor applications) can contain up to 276 fibers.

- The number of fiber-containing elements (tubes) in a cable can range up to 12 for internal cables and 23 for external cables . Some cables also include fillers or dummy elements to maintain structural integrity and prevent fiber movement, but these do not carry data .
