Using Fittings for Branching

Cable Separation and Organization

- Segregate cables by type (power, data, control) using dividers or spacing within the tray to prevent interference .



- Maintain a fill ratio of 40–50% for power cables to allow airflow and heat dissipation .

- Use cable ties or clamps to secure cables along the branch, keeping them neat and preventing sagging .

Support and Mounting

- Install support brackets for the branch at intervals similar to the main tray (typically 1.5–3 meters) to prevent bending or sagging .

- Ensure the branch tray is level and aligned with the main trays to allow smooth cable routing .

Grounding and Bonding

- Connect the branch tray to the main grounding system using bonding jumpers to maintain electrical continuity .

- Verify that all fittings and joints are properly bonded to prevent electrical hazards.

Labeling and Documentation

- Clearly label all cables entering and leaving the branch for easy identification .

- Update as-built drawings to reflect the branch layout for future maintenance or expansion. By following these steps—planning, using proper fittings, maintaining separation, supporting the trays, and grounding—you can safely and efficiently branch side-by-side slotted box-type cable trays while ensuring long-term reliability and compliance with electrical standards.
