

How to branch cables within cable trays

Before creating a branch, plan the route of both the main tray and the branch tray. Identify the destination of the branch cables, ensure adequate clearance, and consider load capacity and cable separation requirements to prevent interference and overheating .

Selecting the Right Tray and Fittings

Choose a compatible tray type for the branch, such as ladder, ventilated trough, or solid-bottom trays, depending on cable type and environmental conditions . Use branch fittings like T-joints, elbows, or wyes to create a smooth transition from the main tray to the branch tray. These fittings maintain structural integrity and prevent sharp bends that could damage cables .

Cable Routing and Separation

- Separate cables by type: Keep power, control, and signal cables in distinct zones to reduce electromagnetic interference (EMI) and simplify maintenance .

- **Maintain bend radius:** Ensure cables are not bent beyond their minimum radius at the branch point to avoid insulation damage .
- **Support cables:** Use cable ties, clamps, or straps to secure cables at the branch and along the branch tray, leaving enough slack for thermal expansion and future adjustments .

Labeling and Documentation

Label each cable clearly at the branch point with type, size, installation date, and purpose. Maintain a wiring map to facilitate troubleshooting and future maintenance .

Grounding and Bonding

If using metallic trays, ensure bonding continuity across the branch and main tray. Metallic trays can serve as an equipment grounding conductor (EGC) if properly bonded according to NEC 392.60 .

Compliance and Safety

- **Cable fill limits:** Do not exceed 40% of the tray cross-sectional area for power cables and 50% for control cables .
- **Clearances:** Maintain at least 12 inches of vertical clearance above trays for safe access .
- **Avoid prohibited areas:** Do not install trays in hoistways or enclosed spaces . By following these steps—planning the route, selecting proper fittings, maintaining separation and support, labeling, and ensuring grounding—you can safely and efficiently branch cables within a cable tray while complying with electrical codes and optimizing system reliability .
