Secure the clamp directly to the exposed metallic component, ensuring proper torque and full contact area . 4. **Connect the Grounding Conductor** Run a minimum 14 AWG copper grounding wire (or as required by local code) from the bonding clamp to the nearest grounding electrode, equipment grounding bus, or building ground. Keep the wire as short and direct as possible, avoiding sharp bends that increase impedance . 5. **Bond at Both Ends (if applicable)** For cable runs spanning multiple buildings or long distances, ground the metallic components at each entry point to prevent induced voltages from lightning or power-line faults . 6. **Verify Continuity** Use a low-resistance ohmmeter to confirm that the metallic component is properly bonded to the grounding system, with a resistance of less than 1 ohm . 7. **Seal and Protect** After grounding, apply a weatherproof sealant or heat-shrink sleeve over the stripped area to prevent moisture ingress, especially for outdoor or direct-burial installations .
