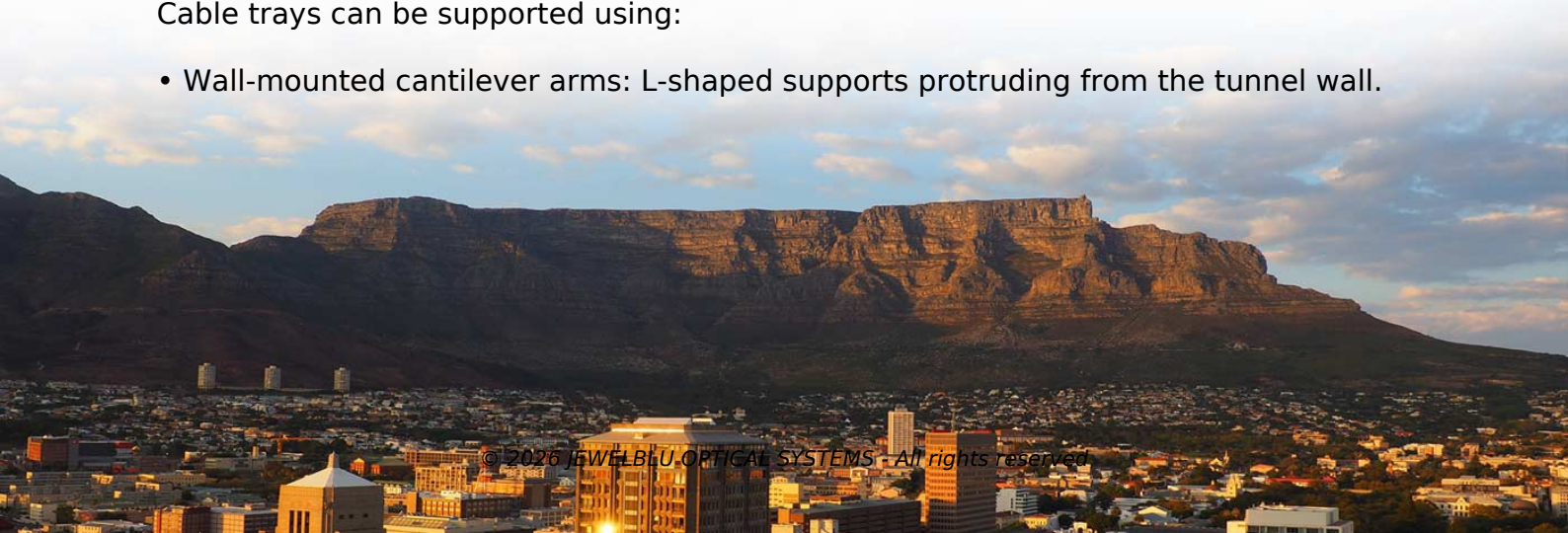
Proper layout of tunnel cable tray supports involves straight, well-spaced lines, secure mounting, and careful separation of cable types to ensure safety, accessibility, and long-term reliability. Planning and Alignment

Begin by tracing the intended path of the cable trays along the tunnel using a laser level or similar alignment tool to ensure straight lines and proper elevation before drilling or installing supports . Tunnels often have long, straight runs, but bends, inclines, and drops must be accounted for in the layout . Modular cable trays, such as ladder-type or wire mesh trays, allow flexibility to navigate tight spaces without modifying the tunnel structure .

Support Types and Spacing

Cable trays can be supported using:

- Wall-mounted cantilever arms: L-shaped supports protruding from the tunnel wall.



- Ceiling-mounted trapeze hangers: Rods and flat bars suspending the tray from above . The distance between supports depends on the tray type, load, and cable weight. Heavy-duty trays carrying power, communication, and signaling cables require adequate spacing to prevent sagging and maintain separation between cable types . Standard practice is to ensure that trays are not overloaded, typically filling only 40–50% of the tray cross-section to allow airflow and prevent overheating .

Cable Separation and Safety

Organize cables by type—power, data, and signaling—to avoid interference and safety hazards. Use dividers, clamps, or covers to maintain separation and protect cables from environmental factors such as moisture, dust, and rodents . In tunnels, fire safety is critical; select trays and accessories that comply with fire-resistance standards (e.g., DIN 4102-12) to maintain functionality of emergency systems during a fire .

Installation Best Practices

- Use splice plates to connect tray sections securely and maintain alignment .
- Flatten sharp edges and ensure all fasteners are rated for the tunnel environment, particularly for concrete or steel surfaces .
- Plan for inspection and maintenance by leaving sufficient space around trays for access .
- Balance load distribution along the tray to prevent structural stress and ensure long-term stability .
