Choose a conduit material suitable for your environment: HDPE is ideal for underground runs due to flexibility and durability, while PVC is common for exposed or trench installations. For a 24-core cable, ensure the conduit diameter allows for proper fill ratio—typically 40% initial fill, 70% maximum—to reduce pulling tension and allow future cable additions. If multiple cables or future upgrades are planned, consider installing innerducts to subdivide the conduit into separate channels.

Cable Handling and Pulling Preparation

- Attach a pulling grip: Use a Kellems grip or swivel pulling eye connected to the cable's strength members (e.g., Aramid yarn), never pull by the jacket alone.
- Lubrication: Apply a fiber-rated, water-based lubricant at the conduit entrance and along the pull path to reduce friction and pulling tension by up to 50%. Avoid petroleum-based lubricants, which can damage the cable jacket.

- Tension monitoring: Use a calibrated dynamometer inline with the pull rope to ensure the pulling force does not exceed the manufacturer's maximum tension (typically 270–600 lbs for standard fiber cables), .

Pulling Technique

- Maintain a steady, moderate pulling speed (50–100 feet per minute) to avoid tension spikes .

- Ensure the cable is never bent below its minimum bend radius, especially at conduit entrances, exits, and bends. A common guideline is 20 times the cable diameter under tension .

- For long or complex runs, consider mid-span access points to re-lubricate and manage tension .

Innerduct and Fill Considerations

- Install innerducts before pulling the cable if multiple fibers or future expansion is expected. A 4-inch conduit can typically accommodate three 1.25-inch innerducts, each holding one fiber cable .

- Maintain proper fill ratios to prevent jamming and excessive sidewall pressure, which can crush the fiber .

Safety and Maintenance

- Seal all open conduit ends daily to prevent moisture and debris ingress .
- Follow safety standards such as OSHA, NEC, and NESC during installation .
- Protect eyes from laser exposure and handle fibers carefully to avoid injury from glass shards . By following these steps—selecting the right conduit, using innerducts, applying proper lubrication, monitoring tension, and respecting bend radius—you can safely and efficiently run a 24-core fiber optic cable through a conduit while ensuring long-term performance and future expandability .
