1. **Check Cable Specifications:** Before installation, consult the cable manufacturer's specifications for maximum pulling tension and minimum bend radius. For example, the minimum bend radius under tension is typically 20 times the cable diameter, while the long-term installed radius is 10 times the diameter . Exceeding these limits can damage the fiber and void warranties.

2. **Use Proper Pulling Equipment:** Attach a Kellems grip or swivel pulling eye to the cable's strength member. Never pull the cable by the jacket alone, as this can cause fiber breakage . For bends, consider using pull wheels or rollers with diameters at least double the minimum bend radius to guide the cable smoothly around curves .

3. **Apply Fiber-Rated Lubricant:** Lubricant reduces friction, especially at bends, and can lower pulling tension by 50% or more. Apply it at the duct entrance and at each pull point along the route . Ensure the lubricant is compatible with both the cable jacket and duct material.

4. **Maintain Proper Pulling Tension and Speed:** Use a calibrated tension meter to monitor pulling force. Standard fiber cables typically tolerate 270–600 lbs of tension, depending on type . Pull at a steady, moderate speed (50–100 feet per minute) to avoid tension spikes that can damage the fiber.

5. **Respect Bend Radius at All Times:** Ensure the cable does not bend below its minimum radius at the duct entrance, exit, or any intermediate bends. For tight bends, use long-radius sweeps or pre-bent factory elbows to reduce stress . Avoid sharp 90-degree turns whenever possible.

6. **Use Pull Boxes or Handholes:** Install pull boxes at every direction change exceeding 90 degrees and at intervals of 150 meters or less. This allows the cable to be fed gradually around bends and reduces friction and tension .

7. **Coiling and Feeding Techniques:** When uncoiling cable, use a figure-eight configuration to prevent kinking or twisting. Keep loops within recommended sizes (e.g., 5–8 ft diameter) and avoid continuous coiling beyond 30 meters .

Additional Tips

- **Innerducts** can subdivide the conduit and provide smoother pathways for multiple cables .
- **Slope and drainage:** Ensure ducts are sloped to prevent water accumulation, which can degrade the cable jacket over time .
- **Safety:** Barricade areas where cable is unreeled to prevent pedestrian or vehicular interference . By following these steps—respecting bend radius, using proper grips and rollers, applying lubricant, and monitoring tension—you can safely thread fiber optic cable through bends in a duct while minimizing the risk of damage and signal loss.
