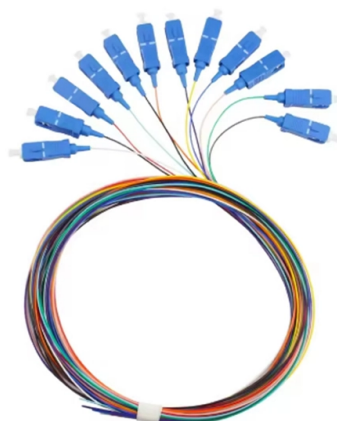

Step-by-Step Installation

- Prepare the Cabinet

 - Regularly inspect and clean the dust cover or filter using a soft brush, vacuum with HEPA filter, or anti-static wipes .
 - Replace filters according to manufacturer recommendations or when airflow is noticeably reduced.

- Placement: Elevate cabinets slightly off the floor and avoid corners to reduce dust accumulation .
- Environment: Keep the surrounding area clean to minimize dust entering the cabinet.
- Customization: Some dustproof enclosures allow upgrades for liquid ingress protection or pest control, depending on environmental needs .
