In contrast to AON, multiple customers are connected to a single transceiver by means of. In general, an OLT is akin to a Network Switch where each port represents one or more client ONT or a node. Each port may be attached to the boards or network/line cards via a SFP module which must be a OLT module for it to have its Tx and Rx wavelengths swapped, but not all OLTs use SFP modules as. User equipment ONU is connected through the ODN network (composed of optical fiber and a passive optical splitter). OLT belongs to the business node side of the access network equipment, connected to the corresponding business node equipment through the SNI interface, to complete the access network service access.
