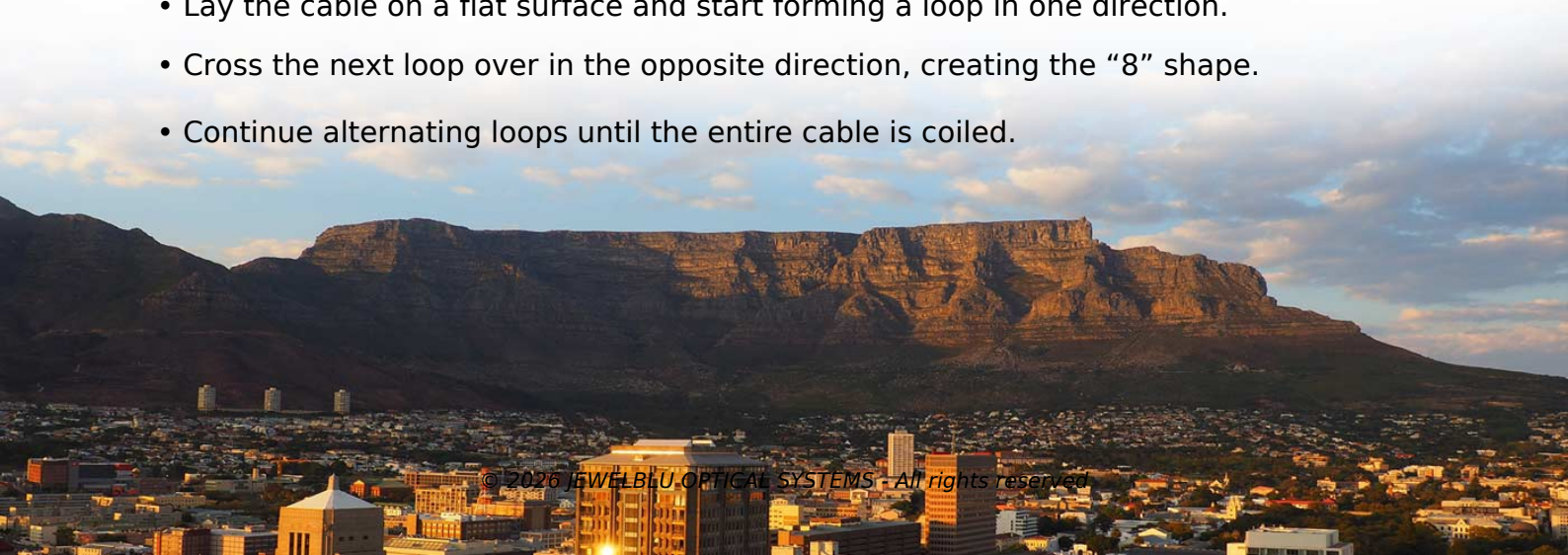

Coiling a pigtail cable in a figure-eight pattern helps prevent torsion and twisting along the cable length, which can damage the internal conductors or degrade signal quality. When a cable is wound in a simple round coil, repeated twists can accumulate, leading to kinks, stress on the connectors, and potential signal loss. The figure-eight method alternates the direction of the loops, effectively canceling out twists and keeping the cable tension-free.

How to Coil a Pigtail Cable in Figure-Eight

- Lay the cable on a flat surface and start forming a loop in one direction.
- Cross the next loop over in the opposite direction, creating the “8” shape.
- Continue alternating loops until the entire cable is coiled.



- Secure the cable with a tie or Velcro strap without tightening too much, ensuring no stress is applied to the connectors.

Benefits

- Prevents torsion and kinks, extending cable life.
- Maintains consistent bending radius, which is critical for coaxial pigtails to preserve signal integrity.
- Simplifies installation, especially in tight spaces or when connecting antennas to routers, APs, or other RF devices .
