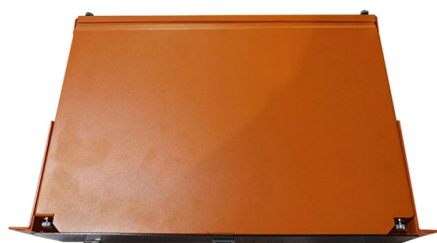

- Multi-mode pigtails: Orange or aqua jacket, 50/125 μm or 62.5/125 μm core, suitable for short-distance applications like within buildings or campuses .

- Simplex pigtails: Single fiber, one connector, ideal for standard terminations.

- Duplex pigtails: Two fibers, two connectors, used for full-duplex communication.

- Splicing: Pigtails are typically fusion or mechanically spliced to the main fiber cable, ensuring low insertion loss and high reliability .
