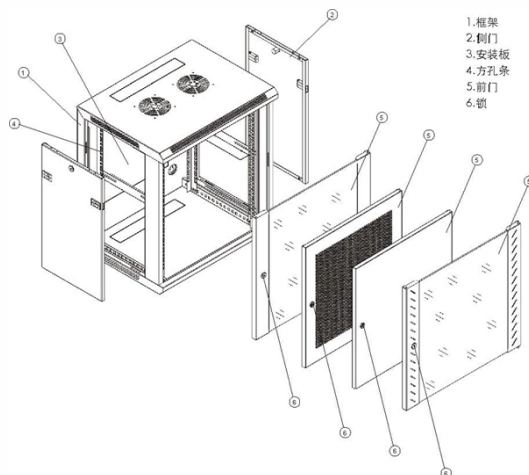


Large-span bridges near Peru



Overview

The largest free span bridge is the 'Dam Bridge' at 54.8m and capable of supporting a load of 50 tonnes. The modular suspension bridges have a great success in Peru, the type of bridge developed by the Austrian company Waagner-Biro has the advantage of being simple and quick to implement. Stretching across the Andes Mountains, Amazon rainforest, and coastal deserts, Peru's. The Chilina Bridge in the Peruvian city of Arequipa, opening 2014, is a segmental continuous pre-stressed concrete viaduct. 3 m-wide decks are box girders with variable depths.
