For example, 3M firestop pillows and putty can be molded around cable trays to create a tight seal, suitable for both concrete and gypsum walls, and are UL listed for rated fire protection periods (e.g., 1–3 hours) (Eaton) . 2. - Conduct routine inspections to maintain seal integrity and replace degraded components promptly.
- Consider modular systems for retrofitting existing installations without full tray replacement. By integrating firestop barriers, modular sealing systems, proper installation, and regular maintenance, cable tray openings can be effectively protected against leakage, ensuring both safety and operational reliability.
