- Customize mechanical systems with traverse units, accumulators, and cooling troughs to match cable type, diameter, and deployment speed. By combining ultra low-loss fiber systems with precision take-up and drop-off frames, you can achieve minimal signal attenuation, maintain fiber integrity, and support high-speed, high-density network deployments efficiently.
