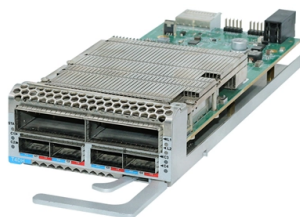

Use cable ties or trays to organize excess fiber inside the box, preventing tension or pinching . Color-code or label fibers if necessary for easier maintenance. Proper cable management reduces signal loss and simplifies future troubleshooting.

Step 6: Seal and Ground the Box

For outdoor installations, apply high-quality gaskets or sealants to prevent moisture ingress . Ensure the junction box is properly grounded to protect against electrical surges and safeguard the optical fibers.

Step 7: Test the Connection

After installation, test the fiber connection using a visual fault locator or Optical Time Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) to verify signal integrity and performance . Contact your service provider if needed to confirm functionality.
