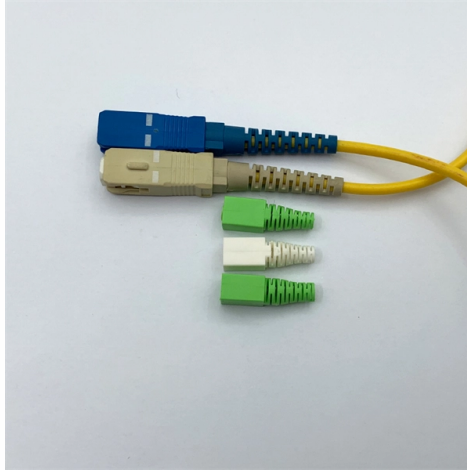

Avoid exposure to moisture, direct sunlight, or extreme temperatures, which can degrade optical performance . 4. Temperature and Environmental Monitoring Ensure modules operate within the manufacturer-specified temperature range. Overheating or exposure to cold can reduce performance and shorten lifespan . High-density data centers should monitor ambient conditions to maintain optimal module operation. 5. Routine Inspection and Troubleshooting Regularly inspect fiber connections and module interfaces. If link failures occur, check for contamination before considering module replacement. Proper inspection can prevent unnecessary downtime and reduce costs associated with replacing expensive 100G modules .

100G Module Specific Considerations
