To access your LUNs using Fibre Channel, you must install Fibre Channel adapters on your Synology NAS.

Fibre Channel (FC) is a high-speed network technology primarily used to connect storage devices in a Storage Area Network (SAN). NAS devices with FC support can act as SAN storage targets, allowing servers and other initiators to access NAS storage over the Fibre Channel fabric. This integration combines the flexibility of NAS with the performance and reliability of FC SANs.

NAS Support for Fibre Channel

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QNAP NAS: By installing a QNAP Fibre Channel card (e.g., QXP-32G2FC or QXP-16G2FC), a QNAP NAS can be added to an existing SAN environment. Features include LUN snapshots, SSD cache acceleration, LUN masking, and port binding for enhanced security . The NAS can operate in target mode, presenting storage to SAN initiators.

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Synology NAS: Synology NAS models support FC through compatible adapters. Administrators can monitor each FC port's status, speed, and frame statistics, and manage connected initiators to access LUNs . This allows the NAS to function as a SAN storage device with enterprise-level management.

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TrueNAS: TrueNAS Enterprise systems licensed for Fibre Channel provide FC ports that can be configured in Sharing > Block Shares. Features include NPIV (N_Port ID Virtualization), which allows multiple virtual N_Ports to share a single physical port, each with its own WWPN. This is particularly useful in virtualized environments for independent management of virtual machines and secure zoning .

- Cost Efficiency: Using NAS with FC can be a budget-friendly alternative to replacing an entire SAN, while still providing enterprise-grade features.

Setup Considerations

- Install a compatible Fibre Channel adapter in the NAS.
- Configure the NAS in target mode using the vendor's management software (e.g., QNAP iSCSI & Fibre Channel app, Synology SAN Manager, or TrueNAS Sharing settings).
- Assign LUNs and configure access controls, including LUN masking and port binding.
- For virtualized environments, configure NPIV and switch zoning to ensure proper access control and isolation. By integrating NAS with Fibre Channel, organizations can leverage existing SAN infrastructure while gaining the flexibility, scalability, and advanced features of modern NAS systems. This approach is suitable for enterprise storage, backup, and disaster recovery planning.
