Two hard drives are required for mirroring (RAID 1) and at least three are required for disk striping with parity (RAID 5). It is strongly recommended that you use hardware-based RAID or software-based disk-fault tolerance for the internal drives. A disk array is a disk storage system which contains multiple disk drives. It is differentiated from a disk enclosure, in that an array has cache memory and advanced functionality, like RAID, deduplication, encryption and virtualization.
