- OPGW (Optical Power Ground Wire): Combines optical fibers with a metallic ground wire, typically installed at the top of transmission towers. Fibers are protected inside a sealed metal tube, surrounded by steel and aluminum conductors, making them immune to electrical interference .
- OPPC (Optical Power Phase Conductor): Similar to OPGW but integrated with phase conductors, allowing fiber deployment along energized lines without affecting power transmission .
- OPAC (Optical Power Attached Cable): Lightweight, all-dielectric fiber cable that can be wrapped around existing power conductors using specialized equipment like a "tug" or cable lasher. This method, sometimes called "Sky-Wrap," allows installation on spans over 2 km and tower heights over 200 m .



- ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting) Cable: Non-metallic, self-supporting fiber cable designed to withstand high tension and extreme weather. It can be installed below power conductors on poles or towers without additional support infrastructure .

Installation Methods

- Wrapping or Lashing: OPAC cables are wrapped around the host conductor with specialized tools, ensuring proper tension and spacing to prevent fiber stress .
- Attachment to Towers or Poles: ADSS cables can be mounted using standard pole hardware, avoiding the need for new support structures .
- Splicing: Fiber splices are typically performed on the ground in protective enclosures attached to towers or buildings. Fusion splicing is recommended for permanent connections .

Safety Considerations

- Only trained personnel should perform installations near energized power lines.
- Special devices are required to prevent coronal discharge at high-voltage points.
- Cables must be dielectric or properly insulated to avoid electrical hazards .
