Busbars are the main electrical pathways in a distribution or switchgear cabinet, carrying current from the incoming supply to multiple outgoing circuits. They are typically made of copper or aluminum for high conductivity and mechanical strength, and they simplify panel layout by allowing direct connections to protection devices and meters (). Proper busbar design considers rated current, thermal performance, short-circuit withstand, and mechanical stability ().

Meter Integration

Power meters are usually connected to busbars via current transformers (CTs) and voltage taps. This allows the meter to measure current, voltage, power, and energy without directly exposing the meter to high currents. Key considerations include:

- CT Placement: CTs should be installed around the main busbars or branch feeders to ensure accurate current measurement ().

- **Voltage Sensing:** Voltage inputs can be taken from busbar terminals or dedicated voltage taps.
- **Isolation and Safety:** Maintain proper separation between live busbars and metering devices, following IEC 61439 standards for forms of separation (Form 2 or Form 3b) ().
- **Minimizing Voltage Drop:** Ensure busbar cross-section and layout minimize voltage drop and harmonic heating, especially in panels with non-linear loads like VFDs or LED lighting ().

Practical Installation Tips

- Use shrouded or insulated tap-off points to connect meters safely without compromising segregation ().
- Ensure maintenance access to meters and busbars without exposing live parts.
- For modular or multi-tenant panels, consider pre-fabricated busbar-to-meter connections to reduce hot spots and improve reliability ().
- Verify that the busbar and meter combination meets short-circuit and thermal ratings of the panel ().

Standards and Compliance

- IEC 61439-1 and IEC 61439-2 govern low-voltage switchgear and metering panel design, including busbar verification for temperature rise, short-circuit rating, and clearances ().
- Coordination with incoming ACBs or MCCBs and outgoing branch devices is essential for safe and accurate metering ().
