Distribution box terminals are essential components that connect incoming and outgoing wires safely and efficiently. They include screw-type terminals, ring terminals, and pigtail terminals, often color-coded for wire gauge identification and insulated to prevent accidental contact. Some terminals are integrated into pre-assembled junction or distribution boxes, which may include waterproof or industrial-grade enclosures with IP65-IP68 protection.

Price Ranges

- Standard screw-type terminals: \$0.10-\$1 per piece for basic residential or commercial use.
- Insulated ring or fork terminals: \$0.20-\$2 per piece, depending on wire gauge and insulation material.

Factors Affecting Terminal Pricing

- Material: Copper or brass terminals are more expensive than aluminum or tin-plated options.

- Insulation: Heat-resistant or chemical-resistant insulation increases cost.

- Voltage and current rating: Higher-rated terminals for industrial applications are pricier.

- Environmental protection: Terminals in IP65-IP68 enclosures or ATEX-certified boxes cost more.

- Quantity and packaging: Bulk purchases reduce per-unit cost, while single-piece purchases may be higher .

Conclusion

For most residential and commercial projects, expect to pay \$0.10-\$3 per terminal, while specialized industrial or hazardous-area terminals can reach \$5 or more per piece. Pre-assembled distribution boxes with integrated terminals will include these costs in the overall enclosure price, which varies widely based on size, material, and certification requirements .
