The fill ratio is calculated by dividing the sum of the cable diameters by the inner diameter of the conduit . 3. Bend Radius: Ensure the conduit allows bends with a radius larger than the cable's minimum bending radius to prevent fiber breakage. Long-radius sweeps are preferred, and pull boxes should be used for long runs to reduce tension . 4. Installation Environment:

- Outdoor/Underground: Conduits protect cables from moisture, rodents, and mechanical damage. Rigid PVC or HDPE conduits are common.
- Indoor: Conduits may be optional in controlled environments but are recommended in commercial or industrial settings for added protection .

- Armored Cables: Conduits may not be strictly necessary, but using them can enhance long-term integrity .
 - 5. Future Expansion: Choose a conduit size that allows additional cables to be installed later without exceeding the maximum fill ratio .

| Gel-filled OSP 6-strand | 1.5–2 inches |
| Larger strand counts or armored cables | 2–2.5 inches |
| Premises innerduct (small runs) | $\frac{3}{4}$, 1, 1 $\frac{1}{4}$, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$, 2 inches depending on fill ratio |
- Best Practices
- Pre-lubricate the conduit for pre-terminated assemblies to reduce pulling tension .
 - Avoid tight bends and excessive pulling force to prevent fiber damage .
 - Use color-coded innerducts for multiple networks to simplify identification and management .
 - For long runs, install pull boxes every 100 feet and limit bends to no more than 270° between pull points . By considering these factors, you can select a conduit that ensures safe installation, protection from environmental hazards, and room for future growth.
