This specification states the requirements for the design, manufacture and testing of prefabricated and modular housings of steel construction used to provide secure and weatherproof protection for indoor electrical distribution equipment. The requirements include for items of major electrical. Design requirements for low voltage distribution boxes cover NEC, IEC, and safety standards to ensure reliable, compliant electrical installations. These Distribution Cabinets are to be outdoor type and to be fabricated out of 2 mm GI sheet steel. IP20 also refers to the electrical.
