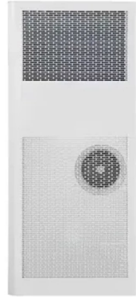


Telecommunication Optical Cable Depth Reference Table



Overview

Fiber optic cables are typically buried between 12 and 36 inches (30-90 cm), depending on installation environment, soil conditions, and load requirements. In high-load areas such as roads or backbone routes, burial depth can reach 48 inches (120 cm) or more. ITU-T has been active in the standardization of optical communications technology and the techniques for its optimal application within networks from the infancy of this industry.
