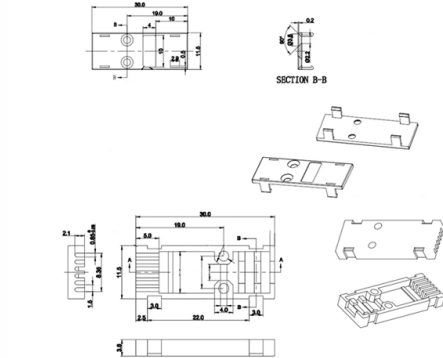

### Common Causes

1. Short Circuit A short circuit occurs when a live wire touches a neutral wire or a grounded metal part, causing a sudden surge of current. This is often accompanied by a popping sound, sparks, or a burning smell. Short circuits are hazardous and can damage wiring or cause fires, so the breaker trips instantly to protect the system . 2. Overload An overload happens when the total electrical load exceeds the breaker's rated capacity. If multiple high-power devices are connected to the same circuit, the breaker may trip immediately or shortly after switching on. This is common in homes with older wiring or when new appliances are added without upgrading the panel . 3. Ground Fault or Earth Leakage A ground fault occurs when electricity flows through an unintended path to the ground, often due to water ingress, damaged insulation, or faulty appliances. Residual-current devices (RCDs) or ground fault circuit interrupters (GFCIs) detect this and trip the breaker to prevent electric shock . 4. Faulty Appliances or Wiring Sometimes, a defective appliance or damaged wiring can cause immediate tripping. Appliances like space heaters, refrigerators, or washing machines may overheat or have internal faults that trigger the breaker .

#### Steps to Diagnose and Fix

- Turn off the main breaker and unplug all devices on the affected circuit.
- Reset the breaker and switch it on with no load. If it trips immediately, the problem is likely in the wiring or the breaker itself.
- Inspect for visible damage such as burnt wires, loose connections, or moisture in outlets and junction boxes.
- Test appliances individually by plugging them in one at a time to identify any faulty device.
- Call a licensed electrician if the breaker continues to trip, especially if a short circuit or ground fault is suspected. Never repeatedly reset a breaker without identifying the cause, as this can lead to fire or equipment damage .

#### Safety Note

Immediate tripping is a warning sign. Avoid using the circuit until the issue is resolved. Handling electrical faults without proper knowledge can be extremely dangerous, so professional inspection is strongly recommended.
