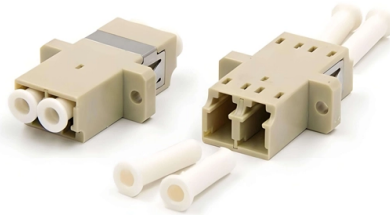

A distribution box, also called a distribution board or breaker box, is the central point where the main 220V supply is divided into multiple circuits for a home or building . It contains protective devices such as:

- Main Circuit Breaker (MCB): Usually a double-pole MCB that receives the incoming 220V supply and controls power to the entire board .
- Single-Pole MCBs: Used for individual output circuits to rooms or appliances.
- RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker): Provides protection against leakage currents, electrical shocks, and insulation faults, typically rated at 30mA for domestic installations .

Wiring and Connections

The 220V single-phase supply consists of two wires: Live and Neutral . The wiring sequence is generally:



- Incoming Supply: Live and Neutral wires from the energy meter connect to the Main MCB.
- Main MCB Output: Connects to the input of the RCCB.
- RCCB Output: Feeds the individual MCBs for each circuit.
- Neutral Link: Distributes neutral to all output circuits.
- Earth Link: Connects the metallic body of the panel, appliances, and earthing pit to ensure safety .

Load Distribution

Each MCB controls a separate load, such as lights, fans, or outlets, allowing parallel connections so that each appliance can be switched independently . For high-power appliances like air conditioners or stoves, a dedicated MCB or double-pole MCB may be used .

Safety Considerations

- Ensure the MCB and RCCB ratings match the load requirements.
- Use appropriate wire gauge to prevent overheating and voltage drops; resistance increases with wire length and decreases with conductor diameter .
- Proper earthing is essential to prevent electric shocks.
- Always turn off the main supply before performing any wiring or maintenance . By following these guidelines, a 220V distribution box can safely and efficiently manage electrical power for a home or small building.
